- VI. Passing criteria for Class V and VIII
- VII. Minimum 75% attendance is mandatory.
- VIII. In order to be declared "Pass" at the end of the session for promotion to next higher class, a student must secure at least 33% marks in each subject studied by him/her during the session. He/she must secure at least 25% of marks in annual examination.
- IX. Passing criteria for Classes III, IV, VI, VII
- X. Minimum 75% attendance is mandatory.
- XI. No detention policy for classes III, IV, VI, VII. However, student will be given opportunity to reappear in IMPROVEMENT EXAMS to strengthen his/her learning outcomes.
